Resurrection Day is Coming!

Lent traditions help us hold space to contemplate Christ's suffering and death before rejoicing at his resurrection on Easter morning. Lent traditions are just that: ways to help us get more out of the time we spend in contemplation, prayer, meditation, and acts of repentance and service. Lenten traditions are tools to be used to draw our attention to God and God's sacrificial love for us in Jesus Christ. Adhering to a tradition for tradition's sake is less authentic than making a conscious, thoughtful choice in the moment of decision that gives glory to God.

Not saying or singing "Alleluia" during Lent, which means "Giving thanks to God," is a tradition that developed in the Western church to show penitence and humility during the season of Lent. Sundays during Lent are technically "little Easters," and not counted in the 40 days of Lent, but the practice of refraining from exclaiming "Alleluia" until Easter morning has remained in tradition.

Prayerfully considering the final days and hours before his death will help us become more thoughtful and engaged in our own faith and therefore to draw closer in our walk with Jesus, knowing what he suffered for us and for our transgressions. Emerging from the empty tomb, Jesus gives witness to the power of God to overcome even death. Therefore, while giving honor to God and remembering Christ's sacrifice for us, let us also give glory to God for God's amazing love.

May the following gatherings and services help to deepen your faith in the One holy triune God.

- ** Each Wednesday through April 23: 1:00 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. "Embracing the Uncertain: A Lenten Study for Unsteady Times."
- ** Sunday, April 6: Fifth Sunday in Lent with Communion. Presbyterian Manor worship with Communion.
- ** Sunday, April 13: Palm Sunday. The Choir and the children will process into the sanctuary waving palm branches during the first hymn to help us remember Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem riding on the back of a humble donkey. Let us explore the joy the disciples and the people felt when Jesus rode into the city, as they acknowledged the One who had been promised to save them. "Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna!"
- ** Thursday, April 17: Maundy Thursday. We will hear the scriptures tell the powerful stories that portray the ways that Jesus was betrayed, abandoned, and suffered to the point of death: death on a cross. The choir will sing "In Remembrance," by Ragan Courtney and Buryl Red.
- ** Friday, April 18: Good Friday. "Tenebrae: A Service of Darkness" by Hal H. Hopson. Through words, music, and light fading into darkness, the suffering, death and burial of Jesus is portrayed.
- ** Sunday, April 20: RESURRECTION SUNDAY! Christ the Lord is Risen Today! Alleluia!

Knitted, crocheted, embroidered, tied fleece. The creators pray over the shawls as they work, and then the shawls are blessed at our monthly meeting. They are distributed by Sunrise nurses and individuals. If you are interested in joining us, we will welcome you! We have yarn and fleece available. Prayer Shawl Ministries meets on the third Sunday of each month at 2pm in the parlor.
